The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Trade is closely monitoring the evolving situation in the Middle East. Guided by Section 35, subsection 3 of the Constitution of Zimbabwe, which states that all Zimbabwean citizens are entitled to several rights and benefits, including the protection granted by the State wherever they may be, the Government of Zimbabwe is fully committed to promoting, protecting and safeguarding the safety and welfare of its citizens living abroad.

Zimbabweans living in or who had travelled to the affected region are urged to register their presence in the region with the nearest Embassy and or Consulate of the Republic of Zimbabwe, and to limit their movements in line with the regulations issued by the authorities of the host countries.
